


DRESS CODE



SHIRTS

Students are required to wear the NW-RI Uniform shirt. Only the top button is allowed to be unbuttoned and long sleeves may not be rolled up. For safety reasons and to establish a professional appearance, shirts need to be tucked in at all times. All shirts must be wrinkle free. Students may also purchase NW-RI logo hats to be worn in the field.



PANTS

All students must wear jeans, or heavy cotton work pants or cargo pants that are black, blue or tan in color. Pants with belt loops must be worn with a black or brown leather belt. Pants cannot have holes or patches. Pants should not restrict movement in any way. This means, no baggy pants or skinny jeans.



OUTERWEAR

Students should bring appropriate weather attire. The Pacific NW is a rainy climate. Raincoat and pants are strongly recommended. Cold weather apparel is also advised. Outerwear cannot be worn in the classrooms except with instructor approval. **NW-RI ID badge is required and may be worn with a lanyard.**



ACCESSORIES AND GROOMING

Students may not wear any jewelry. Hair and facial hair must be clean and neat. Long hair needs to be tied back. Men's nails should be trimmed short. Women's nails should either be trimmed short or to a conservative length and worn with either conservative polish colors or no polish.



SHOES

Students are required to wear 6 inch or higher (must cover the ankle), lace-up, safety toed footwear. The footwear must have a defined heel (90 degree angle from the sole of the shoe and from the ground when standing). Footwear with



HATS

Hats may not be worn in the classrooms. When outside the classroom, an official NW-RI hat may be worn. Hats shall be worn properly with the brim directly in the center of the wearers head, facing forward.
